3. CONDITIONS UNDER WATER ACT:

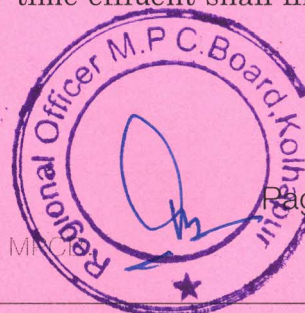
(i) The daily quantity of trade effluent from the factory shall not exceed 8.0M³.

(ii) The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the factory shall not exceed 4.0 M³.

(iii) Trade Effluent :

Treatment: The applicant shall provide comprehensive treatment system consisting of primary / secondary and/or tertiary treatment as is warranted with reference to influent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of the treated effluent to the following standards.

(iv) Trade Effluent Disposal: The treated trade effluent reject shall be recycled in maximum extent & remaining shall be used on lad for gardening. For this sufficient land shall be made available. In no case, at any time effluent shall finds its way to any water body directly or indirectly.



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
