Sub : Closure directions u/s 33A of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 and u/s 31 A of the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 r. w. Hazardous Waste (M,H&TM) Rules, 2016.

WHEREAS, you are operating the industry in the pollution prevention area declared under the Provisions of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 and the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and the Hazardous Waste (Management Handling & Tran boundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

AND WHEREAS, it is obligatory on your part to obtain Conditional Combined Consent and Authorization to operate your industrial plant to discharge sewage and trade effluent in water pollution prevention area subject to certain terms and conditions more precisely under the provisions of 25/26 of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 and section 21 of the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and the Hazardous Waste (Management Handling & Tran boundary Movement) Rules, 2016. **AND WHEREAS,** it was also obligatory on your part to provide adequate and efficient pollution control devices and take adequate measures to control air & water pollution from all sources so as to achieve the standards prescribed in the Environment (Protection) Act 1986.

AND WHEREAS, Hon'ble, Supreme Court of India has passed a Judgment dtd-22/02/2017 in Writ Petition (c) No-375/2012 filed by Parayaran Suraksha Samiti and V/s Union of India & ors directing that, existing industrial units which require consent to operate should make their ETP fully operational as per the norms prescribed by Board within three months. In this regards Board has already publish a public Notice in the leading Newspapers.

AND WHEREAS, this office has received proposal from Sub-Regional Office, MPCB, Bhiwandi reporting following non- compliances.

- 1) During visit secondary treatment facility was not in operational condition and discharging substandard effluent into local body nalla.
- 2) During visit dust collector provided at boiler was not in operational condition.
- 3) Scrubber effluent observed overflowing from collection tank which further flowing outside factory premises.
- 4) During visit rain water mixing with trade effluent and part is going in outside the factory premises without treatment.
- 5) JVS results dtd. 16/02/2019 & 27/02/2019 are exceeding the consented parameters. Stack monitoring results dtd. 22/01/2019 & 28/05/2019 are exceeding the consented parameters.


AND WHEREAS, after examining all the reports and records available with this office I have come to the conclusion that you are knowingly and willfully violating the provisions of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 and Air (P&CP) Act, 1981.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of powers conferred upon me by the Board u/s 33A of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 and u/s 31A of the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981. I, the Regional Officer, Kalyan hereby direct you to stop your manufacturing activity taking all precautionary measures for safe closure of the unit within 24 hours from receipt of this direction. It may also be noted that, the competent authorities are being directed to disconnect the electricity and water supply to your unit.
