In accordance with above cited reference no. 1, M.P.C. Board has granted consent to operate to your industry with certain terms and conditions and it is obligatory on proprietors/ owners' part to comply the same.

Earlier Board officials visited to your industry on 06/09/2023 & 10/04/2024 and reported non-compliances to this office through legal action. Accordingly, Proposed Directions were issued to you vide letter cited at ref. no. 6.

Accordingly, personal hearing extended to you on 12/06/2024 at 2.00 P.M. before undersigned.

Issues related with above incidence were discussed in detail and after due deliberations, following interim directions are issued under Section 33A of the Water (P and CP) Act, 1974 and 31A of the Air (P and CP) Act, 1981 for:

- 1. Provide the suitable sensor for gas, temperature & pressure inside the reactor to regulate the safe operation of the reactor within one month.
- 2. Industry shall comply SOP/guideline for pyrolysis process strictly.
- 3. Industry shall operate & maintain the air pollution control system & safety measures shall be followed strictly.

- 4. Conduct the safety audit. Also, prepare & submit the onsite/off site disaster management plan to MPC Board within one month.
- 5. The industry shall obtain registration from CPCB in r/o plastic waste/ irrigation pipe waste recycling activity
- 6. Industry shall submit B.G. of Rs. 25,000/- towards compliance of these directions. The said B.G. shall be submitted in favour of Regional Officer, MPC Board, Amravati. The B.G. shall be valid upto one year period.

You are hereby directed to comply the above Interim Direction. You shall submit your reply/objections within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of these directions.

In case, you fail to comply with the above Directions, the Board will have no option than to issue final directions as deemed fit in your case such as disconnection of electricity and water supply of your industry, along with suitable legal action without giving you any further opportunity which may please be noted.
