Sub: Closure Directions u/s 33A of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 & u/s 31 A of the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 r. w. Hazardous & Other Wastes (M&TM) Rules, 2016.

WHEREAS, you are operating the industry in the pollution prevention area declared under the Provisions of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 and the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

AND WHEREAS, it is obligatory on your part to obtain Conditional Combined Consent and Authorization to operate your industrial plant to discharge sewage and trade effluent in water pollution prevention area subject to certain terms and conditions more precisely under the provisions of 25/26 of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 and section 21 of the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and the Hazardous and Other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

AND WHEREAS, it is also obligatory on your part to provide adequate and efficient pollution control devices and take adequate measures to control air & water pollution from all sources so as to achieve the standards prescribed in the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 and to disposed the Hazardous Waste to CHWTSDF.

AND WHEREAS, Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, New Delhi passed order dtd.8/5/2013 in Application No. 37/2012 filed by Wassan Singh V/s. State of Punjab, directing the concerned Pollution Control Board and the Central Pollution Control Boards, to file an Action Taken Report (ATR) in the Registry of the Tribunal within a period of three weeks and to ensure that all the procedure for sealing the illegally run / operated factories / unit is immediately.

AND WHEREAS, Hon'ble, Supreme Court of India has passed a Judgment dtd-22/02/2017 in Writ Petition (c) No-375/2012 filed by Parayaran Suraksha Samiti and V/s Union of India & ors directing that, existing industrial units which require consent to operate should make their ETP fully operational as per the norms prescribed by Board within three months. In this regards Board has already publish a public Notice in the leading Newspapers.


AND WHEREAS, this office has received proposal from Sub-Regional Office, MPCB, Pimpri Chinchwad and reported following non- compliances.

- 1) You are operating your industry without obtaining Consent from MPC Board.
- 2) You have not provided effluent treatment plant (ETP) for the treatment of trade effluent and generating effluent from process was found discharging directly into the drainage line without treatment.
- 3) You have not provided air pollution control system to the Zinc Plating Activity and thereby generating acidic fumes in the premises.
- 4) You have not obtained membership of CHWTSDF for disposal of hazardous waste.

AND WHEREAS, after examining all the reports and records available with this office I have come to the conclusion that you are knowingly and willfully violating the provisions of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 and Air (P&CP) Act, 1981.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of powers conferred upon me by the Board u/s 33A of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974 and u/s 31A of the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981. I, the Regional Officer, Pune hereby direct you to stop your manufacturing activity with immediate effect from receipt of this direction. It may also be noted that, the competent authorities are being directed to disconnect the electricity and water supply to your unit.


