WHEREAS, the Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation (MIDC) is the planning Authority for providing infrastructure facilities for the MIDC area and also to ensure that the industries located in the MIDC area should have been provided with proper water supply, roads, drainage lines including proper collection and transportation of effluent line as well as treatment and disposal system to the waste water generated from MIDC area as per the approval of respective authorities.

ANDWHEREAS, the responsibility of treated effluent discharge line lies with the MIDC, and it was obligatory on your part to operate and maintain the same properly.

ANDWHEREAS, the personnel hearing was extended with all the Stake Holders of RIA CETP. i.e. MIDC, Roha Industrial Association (RIA) and CETP Operator on 13.11.2024 before Hon'ble Member Secretary of the Board as referred above (3), wherein the representatives of the MIDC were present. Considering the in-depth discussion and the Minutes of the Meeting received, following direction are issued for immediate compliance....

- 1. You shall carry out the revised survey from the National Institute of Oceanography (NIA) to redefine the discharge point of the disposal of treated effluent.
- 2. You shall verify the adequacy of the existing final treated disposal pipeline of CETP.
- 3. You shall provide the night vision CCTV Camera at the entry of MIDC within one month period.
- 4. You shall conduct a detailed inspection study of all the pipeline's capacity and repair it on priority to avoid leakages.

You are hereby called upon to submit your reply within a period of seven days from receipt of this direction. Failure which, the Board will have no option than to initiate appropriate legal action against your case, as may be deem fit in your case, which may please be noted.

Considering the in-depth discussion and the Minutes of the Meeting received, following direction are issued for immediate compliance....

- 1. You shall repair the UASB tank and use it as a buffer tank to handle the shock load within on month period. MIDC shall provide necessary assistance for the same
- 2. You shall provide the information about acidic / HIGH COD effluent received at the inlet of CETP immediately/ daily to the MPCB and MIDC.
- 3. You shall provide the list of defaulter units those are responsible for discharge of objectionable color and HIDG COD/ TDS effluent.
- 4. You shall carry out the treatability / feasibility study through an authorized institute such as IIT / NEERI/ UDCT to improve the performance of CETP.
- You shall also submit the finding of the above study to the MIDC for necessary modification and retrofitting of the CETP to align with the actual waste water composition and load.
- 6. You shall carry out regular calibration, maintenance and validation of the OCEMS analyzer as per the SOP/ recommendation of the supplier.
