WHEREAS, the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board has granted Consent to Operate u/s 26 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and u/s 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 & Authorization under Rule 6 of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016, on 12/07/2023 which is valid upto 31/03/2026 subject to certain terms and conditions.

AND WHEREAS, it was also obligatory on your part to provide adequate and efficient pollution control devices and take adequate measures to control air & water pollution, so as to achieve the consented standards.

AND WHEREAS, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board has issued Proposed Directions on 31/01/2024 and Interim Directions on 20/02/2024 to the unit. **AND WHEREAS**, News published in Daily Pudhari dtd. 25/04/2024 regarding air pollution problem due to operation of unit in the surrounding area. **AND WHEREAS**, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board is in receipt of telephonic complaint received from Jamghar Grampanchayat. **AND WHEREAS**, visit is carried out by the Board office for investigation of complaint and verification of compliance of interim directions and SRO, Kalyan-3 have reported following non-compliances of consent conditions and interim directions.


- 1) At the time of visit air pollution control system provided to induction furnaces was not found in operation thereby heavy smoke spreading from the shed and roof in the surrounding area was noticed. Also, no emission was observed from the chimney provided to air pollution control system.
- 2) The industry has not provided effective and adequate secondary fumes extraction system as per consent conditions.
- 3) M/s. Sun Metallics and Alloys Pvt. Ltd. is merged in the M/s. Jaideep Metallics & Alloys Pvt.Ltd. The industry has dismantled induction furnace of capacity 10 Ton of M/s. Sun Metallics and Alloys Pvt. Ltd. and same is sold out. M/s. Jaideep Metallics & Alloys Pvt.Ltd. have installed and operated additional induction furnace of capacity 15 Ton without consent of the Board. The industry has not applied for amalgamation of Consent to Operate of M/s. Sun Metallics and Alloys Pvt. Ltd. with Consent to Operate of M/s. Jaideep Metallics & Alloys Pvt.Ltd.

- 4) The industry has stored huge quantity of slag in unscientific manner and not provided adequate air pollution control system to slag crusher.
- 5) The industry has not provided bag / dust collection system to the air pollution control devices.
- 6) The industry has one D. G. Set of capacity 500 KVA whereas consent to operate is obtained for to D. G. Set of capacity 320 and 360 KVA.
- 7) The industry has not furnished bank guarantee as per consent conditions and interim directions.
- 8) The industry has total 400 manpower and not provided sewage treatment plant for the domestic effluent.
- 9) The industry has one dug well for water and not produced CGWA NOC at the time of visit.
- 10) The industry has not upgraded existing air pollution control system as per interim directions so as to avoid air pollution problem in the surrounding area.
- 11) The industry has not provided fumes extraction system for casting machine thereby causing air pollution problem during casting activity.
- 12) The application for Renewal of Consent to Operate of M/s. Sun Metallics and Alloys Pvt. Ltd. is already refused by the Board on 31/01/2024.
- 13) The industry has not complied with consent conditions and interim directions.

AND WHEREAS, in spite of giving reasonable opportunity, after examining the record of your case and the reports of the officers of the Board, it has been observed that you have not complied with the consent conditions and interim directions thereby causing pollution problem in the surrounding area knowingly and willfully.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above non-compliances, you are hereby directed to stop your manufacturing activities forthwith in a safe manner, failing which, the Board will have no option than to initiate appropriate legal action under the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.
