**Sub:** Proposed Directions under section 33 A of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under section 31A of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

- Ref:** 1) Consent to granted by the M.P.C. Board, to the CETP, Talegaon.  
2) Complaint regarding dumping & burning of Hazardous Solid & Liquid Waste in the HRTS area of CETP (M/s. Hydroair Tectonics PCD Ltd. Plot No. 7, Talegaon Industrial Area, Tal:Maval Dist:Pune, causing environmental damages & pollution of River Indrayani.

**WHEREAS**, the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board has granted Consent to CETP, Talegaon Industrial Area, Tal:Maval Dist:Pune, the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 & Authorization under Rule 6 of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016, subject to certain terms and conditions.

**AND WHEREAS**, it is obligatory on the part of CETP to operate and maintain the CETP units and comply with the consent conditions to achieve the standards prescribed by the Board at its consent.

**AND WHEREAS**, you have issued a letter to the CETP vide above ref. no. 3, regarding prohibition of illegal dumping on HRTS site.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Board office is in receipt of complaint regarding dumping & burning of Hazardous Solid & Liquid Waste in the HRTS area of CETP (M/s. Hydroair Tectonics PCD Ltd. Plot No. 7, Talegaon Industrial Area, Tal:Maval Dist:Pune, causing environmen

**AND WHEREAS**, the officials of the Board have visited for checking compliance of consent conditions and carried out the inspection of CETP area for investigation of complaint on 01/01/2025 and it was observed that –

- 1) The HRTS of the CETP at OS No. 2; MIDC Talegaon ( Part 1) is not found operational.
- 2) HRTS land is not provided with Compound wall, Name of the industry, Display Board, Watchman/ security Guard.
- 3) The Whole 50 acre land of HRTS is not provided scientific trenches as HRTS. Only 1 to 2 acre land of HRTS is provided with trenches.
- 4) Nilgiri Plants were observed Scattered in the whole HRTS area but not all over the HRTS along the trenches. Lots of seasonal grass observed in it.

- 5) One natural odha is passing through this HRTS having approximately 40 degree slope towards this odha. This nalla leads to the river Indrayani in rainy season.
- 6) Lots of Municipal solid waste with Organic waste, Plastic, Coconut, mattresses, cushions, foam, plastic bottles, parts of dead plants, cloths, papers, Corrugated boxes are observed in this solid waste, which is in continuously in burning condition causing air pollution in the surrounding area.
- 7) As per information from the representative of CETP, Grampanchayat Ambi, Varale, Nagarpalika Talegaon Dabhade and other adjacent villages are dumping their MSW Waste on the land of HRTS adjacent to Road.
- 8) Land of HRTS not observed with proper pipelines to carry the treated effluent towards HRTS and in the HRTS lines. No valves of pipeline, Chamber, Water flow meter are observed in HRTS as CETP representative also failed to show these points.
- 9) The HRTS area was not maintained properly.
- 10) Shri Ramchandra Ramdas Jadhav has dumped some effluent on the land of HRTS adjacent to Road through their tanker No. MH- 14 AZ-5030.
- 11) The CETP authority has failed to maintain the HRTS area as per consent condition as well as regular vigilance & safety measures so as to prohibit the illegal dumping of hazardous & non hazardous solid waste & liquid waste in the premises of HRTS area which ultimately causing the grave injury to the environment.

**AND WHEREAS**, from the record it has been observed that CETP has failed to comply with the conditions stipulated in the Consent granted by the Board and thereby causing pollution of the surrounding environment.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above non compliances, you are hereby directed to -

1. Direct the CETP authority to lift all stagnated water accumulated in the HRTS area along with solid waste.
2. Direct CETP authority to upgrade the existing HRTS system & provide proper fencing to prohibit the illegal dumping from outsiders.
3. Direct CETP authorities to Operate & Maintain the CETP functional round the Clock so as to achieve the consented norms.

You are hereby directed to submit the action taken report on above non compliances within 7 days from the issuance of these directions, failing which MPCB will have no option than to issue appropriate directions without giving any further notice in accordance with the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, which may please be noted.
