

WHEREAS, you have made application for grant consent to operate and for HW authorization under Section 25 of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and under Rule (6) of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 respectively for recycling of scrap batteries at above site address vide reference No. 1.

AND WHEREAS, your application was discussed in the authorization committee meeting held on 02/12/2021 and committee recommended to defer the case and call information about furnace and air pollution control system provided to the furnace.

AND WHEREAS, Board has issued Show Cause Notice on 07/01/2022 for non-submission about furnace and air pollution control system provided to the furnace. You have not submitted reply to the Show Cause Notice and not submitted the mandatory information as sought in the SCN.

THEREFORE, your application for grant of consent to operate & HW Authorization is hereby refused under Section 27 the Water (P & CP) Act, 1974 and Section 21 of the Air (P & CP) Act, 1981 under Rule (7) of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 as you have not submitted the mandatory information as sought in the SCN. If you are aggrieved by this order, you may prefer an appeal before the competent authority within 30 days from receipt of this order.
