

AND WHEREAS, this office has issued Show Cause Notice vide ref: 2 for following non-compliances:

1. You have not paid fees of linked online consent application UAN No. MPCBCONSENT-0000139307. In absence of which this office is unable to process your BMW Authorization application.

In view of the aforesaid non-compliance on your part, your application for grant of Bio medical waste authorization is hereby refused under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 10(2) of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.

If you are aggrieved with the said Refusal of authorization/Consent, you may prefer an Appeal under Section 28 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under Section 31 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and under Rule 16(1) of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 before the Secretary, Environment Department, Govt. of Maharashtra, within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the said letter.
