WHEREAS, this office is in receipt of your application for grant of Consent to Operate under section 26 of the Water (Prevention of Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

As per the Board's circular dtd.25.08.2025 only the following reasons shall be considered valid for submission of amendment applications in Consent: 1) Typographical or clerical errors in the consent issued to the industry. 2) Change in the name of the industry (subject to supporting documentary evidence).3) Change in the disposal path of Hazardous Waste for pre-processing or coprocessing, as per the policy of the Board. The applications for amendment in consent, which do not fall under the above listed categories. As per the policy of the Board all other applications for amendment in consent, which do not fall under the above listed categories, In view above consent to amendment has been rejected.

In view of above, considering the above noncompliance, your application for grant of Consent to Operate is hereby refused under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 (4) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.
