Grant of Amendment in Consent to Operate under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 6 and Rule 18(7) of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016 is considered and the amendment in consent is hereby granted subject to the following terms and conditions and as detailed in the schedule I, II, III & IV annexed to this order:

1. Following Amendment in Existing Consent :

- The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
- This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/ permission from any other Government authorities.
- The industry shall obtain permission from Directorate of Industrial Safety & Health (DISH).
- The industry shall accept waste electrical and electronic equipment or components not listed in Schedule-I of E-waste Management Rules, 2022 for recycling provided that they do not contain any radioactive material and same shall be uploaded on the portal.
- Industry shall develop green belt on 40 % of the total plot area of the unit. Industry shall also develop greenbelt outside the project premises such as avenue plantation, plantation in vacant areas, social forestry etc.
- The industry shall file annual and quarterly return of E-waste in the laid down form on the portal on or before the end of month succeeding the quarter or year, as the case may be, to which the return relates.

8. The industry shall properly collect, transport and regularly dispose the hazardous waste to CHWTSDF, in compliance of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and keep proper manifest thereof.
9. The industry shall collect E-waste generated during the process of refurbishing and hand over the waste to registered recycler and upload the information on the portal.
10. The industry shall ensure that residue generated during recycling process is disposed of in an authorized treatment storage disposal facility
11. The industry shall obtain Registration from Central Pollution Control Board under Sub-Rule (4) & (7) of the E-waste Management Rules, 2022 for the collection, segregation, dismantling & refurbishing of E-waste.
12. The applicant shall make an application for renewal of consent 120 days prior to date of expiry of the consent.
13. The industry shall file annual and quarterly return of E-waste in the laid down form on the portal on or before the end of month succeeding the quarter or year, as the case may be, to which the return relates.
14. The industry shall accept waste electrical and electronic equipment or components not listed in Schedule-I of E-waste Management Rules, 2022 for recycling provided that they do not contain any radioactive material and same shall be uploaded on the portal.
15. The industry shall maintain records of E-waste collected, dismantled, recycled and sent to the registered recycler on the portal and make available all records for verification or audit as and when required.
16. The industry shall strictly comply with the provisions of the E-Waste Management Rules, 2022 and amendments thereto
17. This consent is issued with overriding effect on earlier Consent to Operate granted by the Board vide no. Consent No. Format1.0?RO-HQ/UAN No. MPCB-CONSENT-0000281907/CR/2606001133 dtd. 12/06/2026 which is valid up to 31/05/2029.
18. The applicant shall strictly comply with the circular issued by the Board vide No. MPCB/JD(APC) / NACP / DG Set / B-0090 dtd. 02/06/2023 regarding Retrofitting of Emission Control Device (RECD) for in-use Diesel Operated Internal Combustion Engines / D.G Sets.
19. The industry shall create an Environment Cell by appointing an Environmental Engineer / Expert for looking after day-to-day activities related to Environment / Pollution control.
