WHEREAS, this office is in receipt of your application for grant of Consent to Operate under section 26 of the Water (Prevention of Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

AND WHEREAS, this office has issued scrutiny letter vide above reference (2) as applied for consent to operate.

AND WHEREAS, you have submitted reply which is not satisfactory as failed to submit penal fee as per MPCB circular dtd.12.07.2022 for penal fee i.e three time of one term consent fee\*no.of years of violation industry shall pay additional consent fee of Rs.5000/-, i.e 15000\*458 days = 18822/ 2. As per earlier consent CI was Rs.25.00 Lakh. Now at the time consent. CI is Rs. 83.79 lakh. There is increasing in CI by Rs.58.79 Lakh. Please submit the clarification/ justification for increase in CI. Submit the additional Rs.1500/-period for increasing CI. Submit head wise details of increase in C.I along with additional Consent fees.

In view of above, considering the above noncompliance, your application for grant of Consent to Operate is hereby refused under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 (4) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981. You are hereby directed not to take any effective steps towards operation of the unit without permission of the Board, else Board will initiate legal action as per the provisions of Environmental enactments.

If you are aggrieved by this order, you may prefer on appeal as per provision in the Water (P&CP) Act 1974 & the Air (P&CP) Act 1981 within 30 days' time from the date of receipt of this letter.
