Sub: Refusal of amendment of Consent to Operate under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 (4) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

WHEREAS, this office is in receipt of your application for grant of amendment Consent to Operate under section 26 of the Water (Prevention of Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

AND WHEREAS, as per the attached documents Board has granted CCA to your hospital on 17.05.2022 for 100 beds. AND WHEREAS, now vide letter dated 28.03.2026 you have requested to issue certificate for total 50 beds with 10 dedicated Ayurveda beds, which is not supported by Bombay Nursing Home registration obtained for 100 beds. AND WHEREAS, SRO- Mumbai-IV has also informed that since there is contradiction in the data submitted; Amendment application may be refused.

AND WHEREAS, it seems that you have submitted documents which are not satisfactory and failed to submit required documents for amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of aforesaid non-compliances, your application for amendment of Combined Consent and BMW Authorisation is hereby refused, under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 (4) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and under Rule 10 (2) of Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016,

If you are aggrieved with the said refusal of your application for CCA, you may prefer an appeal u/s 28 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and u/s 31 of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and u/s 16(1) of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 before the Principal Secretary, Department of Environment & Climate Change, Govt of Maharashtra, within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of this order.
