Sub: Refusal of Consent to Operate under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 (4) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

You have applied for Amendment in the existing Consent to Operate for manufacturing of H-Acid - 180 MT/Month, with a proposal for change in the product name and use of Dilute/Spent Sulphuric Acid (28-45%) as raw material. The application has been scrutinized, and the following observations are made:

1. The Board has accorded Renewal of Consent to Operate vide dated 30.12.2025 for manufacturing of H-Acid - 180 MT/Month, which is valid up to 31.12.2030.
2. The industry has applied for amendment in the existing Consent to Operate for change in the name of the product H-Acid and for utilization of Dilute/Spent Sulphuric Acid (28-45%) as raw material.
3. The proposed utilization of Dilute/Spent Sulphuric Acid (28-45%) as raw material requires obtaining the requisite permission under Rule 9 of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, as applicable. The said permission has not been submitted along with the application.
4. As per the relevant Board Circular, amendment in Consent is not applicable for certain matters, including change in the name of the unit, typographical errors, and change in the hazardous waste disposal route for co-processing/re-processing. Therefore, the proposed amendment shall be considered only in accordance with the applicable provisions and Board guidelines.
5. The industry has not submitted the requisite Rule 9 permission/authorization for utilization of Dilute/Spent Sulphuric Acid (28-45%) as raw material. In the absence of the required statutory permission, the proposed amendment cannot be considered at this stage.
6. In view of the above deficiencies and non-submission of the requisite statutory permission, the application for Amendment in Consent to Operate is hereby refused.
