Grant of Amendment in Consent to Operate under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 6 and Rule 18(7) of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016 is considered and the amendment in consent is hereby granted subject to the following terms and conditions and as detailed in the schedule I, II, III & IV annexed to this order:

1. Following Amendment in Existing Consent :

1	Sr. No.(4) Micronized Rubber Powder - 8000 MT/A and Sr.No. (7) MRP -12000 MT/A	Sr.no. (4)Micronized Rubber Powder (MRP)-20000 MT/A & Sr.No.(7) deleted.

2. The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
3. This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/ permission from any other Government authorities.
4. This consent is issued with overriding effect on earlier Consent to Operate (expansion) granted vide Format1.0/RO(BMW)/UAN No.0000289487/CO/2606001408 dated 16.06.2026 Valid upto 31.03.2032 with all consent conditions unchanged.
5. The industry shall not carry expansion / additional investment / modernization / upgradation / additional construction without prior permission of the Board.
6. Industry shall obtain necessary permission from the Directorate of Industrial Safety & Health (DISH) & Fire Department NOC time to time.

7. The Public Liability Insurance (PLI) Act 1991 referred to PLI Act 1981 provides a mandatory Public Liability Insurance for an owner, industry or Installation handling its liability arising out of accident involving Hazardous Chemicals.
8. Industry shall not abstract and use ground water without obtaining permission from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA).
9. This consent is issued subject to outcome of Notification to be issued by Central Government w.r.t an order passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court dtd.10/08/2022 in accordance with the boundary of Tansa Wild Life Sanctuary & set aside the NGT Order dtd. 27/02/2019.
10. The industry shall comply with provisions made in Plastic Waste Management & Handling Rules 2016, as amended and Maharashtra Plastic and Thermocol Products (MUSTH&S) Notification, 2018, as amended and obtain Registration as well as EPR under these rule, as applicable.
11. Industry shall prepare on-site emergency plan and execute at the time of emergency.
12. Industry shall comply with order passed or to be passed by Hon'ble NGT and Courts in the matter of Tyre Pyrolysis plant.
13. The industry shall comply with provisions of Hazardous Waste Amendment Rule, 2022.
14. Industry shall strictly carry out the production as per the activity and quantity mentioned in the consent. In the event, any variation observed the said consent will be revoked with immediate effect and the Board will initiate stringent legal action against the project Proponent.
15. Industry shall not use crumb rubber manufactured by using imported tyre scrap for tyre pyrolysis activity.
16. Industry shall not sell crumb rubber manufactured by using imported tyre scrap to tyre pyrolysis industries.
17. Industry shall obtain EPR registration under Hazardous and other Waste (M & TM) Amendment Rules, 2022.
18. Industry shall obtain EPR Registration as 'Plastic Waste Re-processor' from Central Pollution Control Board / Maharashtra Pollution Control Board as per provisions of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 for the re-processing of scrap plastic.
19. In line with the policy adopted by MoEF&CC, Unit shall not to import waste tyres for the purpose of TPO production. Unit to use only indigenous generated waste tyre (i.e. Waste tyre generated in India only). Also unit to sell its products to Actual Users only.
20. The Tyre Pyrolysis Oil unit to fulfill fuel quality as specified by Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas / Bureau of Indian Standards as and when the same gets notified
21. Industry shall comply conditions as per the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Recycling of Waste Tyre Scrap for the Recovery of Tyre Pyrolysis Oil, Pyro Gas and Char in Tyre Pyrolysis Oil (TPO) Units dated 16/01/2024 published by CPCB.

This consent is issued on the basis of information/documents submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent, if it has been observed that the information submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent is false, misleading or fraudulent, the Board reserves its right to revoke the consent & further legal action will be initiated against the Applicant/Project Proponent.
