Grant of Amendment in Consent to Operate under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 6 and Rule 18(7) of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016 is considered and the amendment in consent is hereby granted subject to the following terms and conditions and as detailed in the schedule I, II, III & IV annexed to this order:

1. Following Amendment in Existing Consent :

3	Balance amount of Rs. 125000 will be considered at the time of next renewal of consent.	Existing balance fee of Rs. 1,25,000/- 09/03/2022 is adjusted for this consent. Period for two term consider and balance will be Rs. 2,25,000/- will be considered at the time of next renewal of consent.

- The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
- This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/ permission from any other Government authorities.
- The industry shall obtain necessary permission from the Directorate of Industrial Safety and Health (DISH).
- The applicant shall not carry out any excess production or produce new products without Consent of the Board and without Environmental Clearance wherever it applicable.

6. The applicant shall properly collect, transport & regularly dispose-off the Hazardous Waste to CHWTSD, in compliance of the Hazardous and other Waste (M & TH) Rule-2016 and keep proper manifest thereof.
7. Industry shall obtain the permission from CGWA within 3 months period for drawing ground water for the project activities.
8. This Consent is issued without prejudice to the order passed as may be passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay, in the matter Interim Application. No. 1082/2021.
9. This consent is issued as per the Office Order for Consent Management of the Board No. 12/2020 dtd. 23.12.2020.
10. Industry shall switch over to cleaner fuel instead of F.O. as per Board's Circular dtd. 05.02.2020.
11. The applicant shall make an application for renewal of consent 120 days prior to date of expiry of the consent.

This consent is issued on the basis of information/documents submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent, if it has been observed that the information submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent is false, misleading or fraudulent, the Board reserves its right to revoke the consent & further legal action will be initiated against the Applicant/Project Proponent.
