## Terms and Condition

- The authorized Person shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protegrion) Act, 1986, and the Rules made there under.
- station shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer zed by the prescribed authority.
- De authorized person shall not rent, lend or sell the biomedical waste or facility. The authorized person can transfer the BMW generated at above premises to the "Transporter" or "Operator of Facility" authorized by MPCB under Bio-Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998 for collection, transportation, treatment and/or disposal of BMW generated.
- Any unauthorized change in equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of this authorisation.
- 5. It is the duty of the authorized person to take prior permission of the prescribed authority to close down the facility.
- 6. The authorisation is granted for generation of Bio-Medical Waste (BMW) in waste categories and quantities listed here in below:

7. The liquid/solid waste generated from the treatment activity (from laboratory and washing, cleaning, housekeeping and disinfecting activities) shall be treated suitably by providing effluent treatment facility to conform the standards prescribed in Schedule V of said Rules and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

 (i) BMW shall be treated and disposed of in accordance with Schedule I; and in compliance with the standards prescribed in Schedule V of said Rules.

(ii) You shall setup requisite BMW treatment facilities like incinerator, autoclave / Microwave, shredder etc., at the disposal side in accordance with the BMW rules. You shall disposed of the duly treated BMW and incineration ash in secured land fill site at your own premises / at MSW secured land fill site of Municipal Council authorized by MPCB and duly earmarked for disposal of treated BMW / at common H.W. treatment &

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authorized by MPCB.

9. (i) BMW shall not be mixed with other wastes or reused, recycled or sold in any form.

(ii) BMW shall be segregated into containers / bags at the point of generation iraccordance with Schedule-II prior to storage, treatment and disposal. The containers shall be labeled according to Schedule III.

(iii) If a container containing BMW is to be transported from the premises where BMW is generated to any waste treatment facility outside the premises the container shall, apart from the Label prescribed in Schedule III, also carry information prescribed in Schedule IV and shall be transported by authorized Transporter only.

(iv) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 or Rules there under, BMW shall be transported only in such vehicle as may be authorized for the purpose by the competent authority as specified by the Government.

(v) No untreated BMW shall be kept stored beyond period of 48 hours.

Standards for waste autoclaving:
 The autoclave should be dedicated for the purposes of disinfecting and treating bio- medical waste,

(I) When operating a gravity flow autoclave, medical waste shall be Subjected to:

(i) a temperature of not less than 121 Co and pressure of 15 pounds per Square inch (psi) for an autoclave residence time of not less than 60 minutes; or

(ii) a temperature of not less than 135 C and a pressure of 31 psi for an autoclave residence time of not less than 45 minutes; or

(iii) a temperature of hot less than 149 Co and a pressure of 52 psi for an autoclave residence time of not less than 30 minutes.

(II) When operating a vacuum autoclave, medical waste shall be subjected to a minimum of one pre-vacuum pulse to purge the autoclave of all air. The waste shall be subjected to the following.

a temperature of not less than 121 Co and a pressure of 15 psi for an autoclave residence time of not less than 45 minutes; or

(ii) a temperature of not less than 135 Co and a pressure of 31 psi for an autoclave residence time of not less than 30 minutes; or

- (III) Medical waste shall not be considered properly treated unless the time, temperature and pressure indicators indicate that the required time, temperature and pressure were reached during the autoclave process. If for any reasons, time temperature or pressure indicates that the required temperature, pressure or residence time was not reached, the entire load of medical waste must be autoclaved again until the proper temperature, pressure and residence time were achieved.
- (IV) Recording of operational parameters, Each autoclave shall have graphic or computer recording devices which will automatically and continuously monitor

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parameters throughout the entire length of the autoclave cycle.

- (V) Validation test: Spore testing The autoclave should completely and consistently kil → the approved biological indicator at the maximum design capacity of eaclautoclave unit. Biological indicator for autoclave shall be Racillusstearothermophilus spores using vials or spore strips, with at least 1x 10 sporesper milliliter. Under no circumstances will an autoclave have minimum op parameters less than a residence time of 30 minutes, regardless of temperaturant. pressure, a temperature less than 121 Chor a pressure, less than 15 pd.
- (VI) Routine Test. A chemical indicator strip/tape that changes color who temperature is reached can be used to verify that a specific temperature has been achieved. It may be necessary to use more than one stripped or the waste package at different location to ensure that the inner contemporable package has been adequately autoclaved.

11. Every 'Authorized Person' shall submit an Augus Apover to the prescriber authority in Form-II by 314 January every year about the information when the categories and quantities of EMW handled charles the partition year.

- 12. (i) Every 'Authorized Person' shall maintain record respect to the generation, collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment, disposal and (i) any thrum of handling of BMW in accordance with these Pulse and any middless in the condense with these Rules and any guidelines issued.
