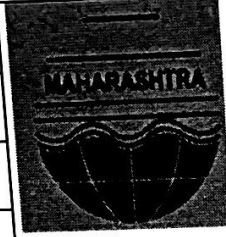

WHEREAS, you have applied for grant of renewal of consent under provisions of Section 26 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the Hazardous Waste (Management & Transboundry Movement) Rules, 2016.

AND WHEREAS, your application is approved for renewal of consent to operate under Red Category subject to compliance report as per SOPS & present status of Pollution control system. However, SRO Thane 2 visited your industry on 20/07/2020 & reported that your industry not in operation & closed from last two year.

Therefore, your application for grant of renewal of consent is hereby refused under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981. If you are aggrieved by thus order, you may prefer on appeal as per provisions in the Water (P & CP) Act, 1974 & the Air (P & CP) Act, 1981 within 30 days' time from the date of receipt of this letter.
