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LETTER of AUTHORISATION

Ref : Your application for Grant of Renewal of authorisation for collection, reception, storage, transportation & disposal of out dated and rejected chemicals (HW Category 28.4 & 28.5) under Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, dt: 22/03/2019.

2. **M/s. Novartis India Ltd.**, C/o Mayur Agencies, Bldg No. D-9, Gala No.202/203/204/205, 2nd Floor, Parasnath Complex, Anjur Dapode Road, Bhiwandi, Dist. Thane; is hereby granted an authorisation for collection, reception, storage, transportation & disposal of Hazardous Wastes mentioned in Schedule-I of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (M &TM) Rules, 2016.
3. The authorisation is valid for collection, reception, storage, transportation & disposal of following Hazardous Waste generated under Schedule-I of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (M &TM) Rules, 2016.

4. **The authorization shall be for period upto 31/12/2019.**

5. The authorization is subject to the following general and specific conditions.
6. The authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and sub conditions as may be specified in the rules in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
7. The firm shall follow guidelines of storage of incinerable hazardous waste as per Hazardous & Other Wastes (M&TM) Rules, 2016.
8. The firm shall submit annual returns in form-4 as per Hazardous & Other Wastes (M&TM) Rules, 2016 to this office along with a copy to concerned RO / SRO office.
7. The Hazardous Waste shall be transported through authorised Hazardous Waste transporter.
8. The manifest system as per rule 19(1) in the Form No. 10 shall be implemented during transportation of Hazardous Waste as per the Rule.

- General Conditions:

1. The authorised person shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorised shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous and other wastes except what is permitted through this authorisation.
4. Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
5. The person authorised shall implement Emergency Response Procedure (ERP) for which this authorisation is being granted considering all site specific possible scenarios such as spillages, leakages, fire etc. and their possible impacts and also carry out mock drill in this regard at regular interval of time.
6. The person authorised shall comply with the provisions outlined in the Central Pollution Control Board guidelines on "Implementing Liabilities for Environmental Damages due to Handling and Disposal of Hazardous Waste and Penalty"
7. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the State Pollution Control Board to close down the facility.
8. The imported hazardous and other wastes shall be fully insured for transit as well as for any accidental occurrence and its clean-up operation.
9. An application for the renewal of an authorisation shall be made as laid down under these Rules.
10. Any other conditions for compliance as per the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change or Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
11. Annual return shall be filed by June 30th for the period ensuring 31st March of the year.

B: Specific conditions:

1. This Authorisation shall be produced at the time of inspection upon request of an officer authorised by the Ministry of Environment & Forests (MoEF) / Central Pollution Control Board / MPCB.
2. Transportation, processing, treatment and disposal of wastes shall be carried out strictly as per the Guidelines on Management & Handling of Hazardous Waste, 1991 Issued by MoEF and in accordance with the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

3. Application (in triplicate) for renewal of Authorisation shall be made well in advance to MPCB, at least three months before expiry, in the Form-1 along with each of the documents as per requirement of Rule-6 Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
4. The Authorisation may be cancelled or suspended by MPCB as per Rule-7 of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, in case the failure of compliance with any of the conditions of the registration or with any of the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 as amended or Rules made there under.
5. In addition to above MPCB may stipulate further conditions, if so required, in the interest of environment protection.
6. **Additional specific Conditions: Industry shall obtain permission from MMRDA for regarding location of the industry within six months' period.**
