2. The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.

3. This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/ permission from any other Government authorities.
4. The industry shall obtain necessary permission from the Directorate of Industrial Safety and Health (DISH).
5. The applicant shall comply with the conditions of the Environmental Clearance granted by Env. Department, GoM vide No.- SEIAA-EC-0000002368 on 08.10.2021.
6. Industry shall install online continuous monitoring system as per CPCB guidelines & data to be transmitted directly from Data Logger to Board server.
7. Industry shall obtain PESO license / approval for storage of flammable Chemicals from the competent authority.
8. This Consent is issued without prejudice to the order passed as may be passed by the Hon'ble NGT, in the matter O.A. No. 1038/2018.
9. This consent is issued as per the Office Order for Consent Management of the Board No. 12/2020 dtd. 23.12.2020.
10. The applicant shall not carry out any excess production or produce new products without consent of the Board and without an Environmental Clearance, if requires.
11. Industry shall comply with mechanism for Environmental Management prepared by Central Pollution Control Board for comprehensive Environment pollution Index (CEPI) listed areas, as industry falls under severally Polluted Area (SPA) of CEPI, If fails consent shall be revoked.
12. The treated effluent shall be sent to M/s. SEE and TEPS Joint Venture only in contingency situations, subject to compliance with all applicable conditions and permissions. This Consent is issued incorporating the conditions of the earlier Consent granted by the Board vide Consent No. Format1.0/AS(T)/UAN No. MPCB-CONSENT-0000255380/CR/2509002729 dated 25.09.2025, valid up to 30.06.2030. All other terms and conditions of the said earlier Consent shall remain unchanged and shall be binding on the industry.
13. The applicant shall make an application for renewal of consent 120 days prior to date of expiry of the consent.
14. The industry shall create an Environment Cell by appointing an Environmental Engineer / Expert for looking after day-to-day activities related to Environment / Pollution control.

This consent is issued on the basis of information/documents submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent, if it has been observed that the information submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent is false, misleading or fraudulent, the Board reserves its right to revoke the consent & further legal action will be initiated against the Applicant/Project Proponent.
