LETTER of AUTHORISATION

1. Number of Authorisation:

2. Reference: Your application for grant of renewal of authorisation for transport of hazardous and other wastes under the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 dtd. 16/06/2016.

1. M/s. Minerva Trading Corporation, Plot No. 11, Shakir Compound, Near Mahim Rly. Crossin, Dharavi Road, Mumbai-400 017, is hereby granted an authorisation based on the enclosed signed inspection report for transportation of hazardous or other wastes or both Schedule I & II of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 from various industrial unit located in Maharashtra to registered recycling / re-refining industry having valid consent/ authorization from CPCB/MPCB or to CHWTSDF or CETP's.

2. The Authorisation granted is valid for a period of Five Years i.e. up to 31/05/2022 however the Board can revoke the same if the performance of the applicant is found unsatisfactory and not as per the conditions of this authorization.

3. You shall transport hazardous or Other Wastes or Both through vehicles bearing No: MH-04/BG-5397 authorized by MPCB, subject to the following general and specific conditions:

A. General conditions of authorisation:

1. The authorised person shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorisation shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorised shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous and other wastes except what is permitted through this authorisation.
4. Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
5. The person authorised shall implement Emergency Response Procedure (ERP) for which this authorisation is being granted considering all site specific possible scenarios such as spillages, leakages, fire etc. and their possible impacts and also carry out mock drill in this regard at regular interval of time.
6. The person authorised shall comply with the provisions outlined in the Central Pollution Control Board guidelines on "Implementing Liabilities for Environmental Damages due to Handling and Disposal of Hazardous Waste and Penalty"
7. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the State Pollution Control Board to close down the facility.



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8. The imported hazardous and other wastes shall be fully insured for transit as well as for any accidental occurrence and its clean-up operation.
9. The record of consumption and fate of the imported hazardous and other wastes shall be maintained.
10. The hazardous and other waste which gets generated utilisation of imported hazardous or other wastes shall be treated and disposed of as per specific conditions of authorisation.
11. The importer or exporter shall bear the cost of import or export and mitigation of damages if any.
12. Any other conditions for compliance as per the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change or Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
13. An application for the renewal of an authorisation shall be made as laid down under these Rules.

B. Specific conditions:

1. The authorisation is valid within the state of Maharashtra only.
2. You shall follow manifest system as per Rule 19(1). You shall maintain all the necessary records & submit it to this office along with copy to concerned Regional Office / Sub Regional Office. You shall also submit form-4 of the Rules.
3. The transporter shall strictly follow the provisions under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and rules made there under.
4. You shall install 'Global positioning system' (GPS) to your Hazardous & Other Wastes transporting vehicle and accordingly inform to this office. Also pay the yearly charges to the GPS provider.
5. Transporter shall prior intimate the monthly transportation program of Hazardous Waste to concern Sub Regional Office including vehicle number, name of industry from where Hazardous Waste is going to be lifted, type of Hazardous Waste, approx. quantity of Hazardous Waste and destination for final disposal/recycle of Hazardous Waste. Without intimation of monthly program transporter shall not carry out Hazardous Waste transportation.
6. The applicant shall comply with conditions as stipulated under Annexure-I enclosed.
7. This is issued with the approval of Member Secretary of the Board.
