Sub: Refusal of Combined Consent to Operate & BMW Authorization renewal application under the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 10 (2) of the Bio-Medical Wastes Management Rules, 2016.

Ref: 1. Your application for grant of renewal of Combined Consent to Operate & BMW Authorization received to MPCB, HQ on 16.09.2020.
2. SCN for refusal of application issued on 30.09.2020.
3. Minutes of personal hearing dated 07.01.2021.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6,8 and 25 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 has notified the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016, for proper management and handling of the Bio-medical Waste.

AND WHEREAS, refer to your application for grant of renewal of Combined Consent to Operate & BMW Authorization under the provisions under section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 Authorization under Bio-Medical Wastes Management Rules, 2016, received through Sub Regional Officer, Chandrapur .

AND WHEREAS, it was brought to your notice that you have failed to submit required documents & information vide online scrutiny letters dated 05.09.2020 and SCN for refusal dated 30.09.2020 & opportunity of hearing given to you by extending personal hearing on 07.01.2021 for submission relevant information, but you have failed to submit followings: -

1. Explanation for delay in submission of application is not submitted.
2. Valid BNH registration certificate for 100 beds is not submitted.
3. Valid CBMWTSDF membership for 100 beds is not submitted.
4. You have submitted PAN Card of VRG Health care Pvt. Ltd., but details of correlation between VRG Health care Pvt. Ltd. & hospital is not submitted.
5. You have not submitted BMW annual report for period of 2019 as per the BMW rules, 2016.
6. Details of category & quantity monthly BMW generation with bifurcation as per schedule III of BMW Rules, 2016 is not submitted.
7. You have not submitted information of all sources of water supply & water budget details, as water bills showing less supply & more differences in water bills.
8. You have not submitted technical details of ETP with capacity, O & M records & photographs.
9. BG extended details of Rs. 2.0 Lakhs are not submitted.
10. You have failed to submit current period CA certificate for Capital Investment without land cost.
11. You have submitted consent & BMW authorization fees as per capital Investment, but if Capital Investment is increased, you have to submit additional fees for increase in capital investment.
12. You have not submitted clarification on SCN was issued by Regional Officer, Nagpur vide letter dated 14.03.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the improper and non-submission of relevant information shows your negligent attitude towards implementation and management of Bio-Medical waste Management Rules, 2016.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the aforesaid non-submission of relevant information & not attend personal hearing dated 07.01.2021, your application for renewal of Combined Consent to Operate & BMW Authorization under the provisions under section 27 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 10 of the Bio medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 is hereby refused.

If you are aggrieved with the said refusal of Combined Consent to Operate & BMW Authorization application, you may prefer appeal under section 28 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the under section 31 Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and under rules 16 (1) of the Bio medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 before the Secretary, Environment Deptt., Government of Maharashtra, within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the said refusal order.
