

WHEREAS, you have applied for grant of 1st consent to operate under provisions of Section 26 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the Hazardous Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

AND WHEREAS, the application was discussed in Consent Committee Meeting of the Board on 06/02/2020 and issued Show cause Notice for refusal of consent vide letter dated 03/03/2020 as non-compliances observed.

AND WHEREAS, the case was again discussed in consent committee meeting held on 26/05/2020 & it was decided to issue final refusal of consent to operate and stop work order as you have failed to reply to SCN issued by the Board dated 03/03/2020 regarding not installed plant and machinery and pollution control system and not submitted the compliance report as per SOP prepared by CPCB for utilization of Hazardous waste under rule 9.

Therefore, your application for grant of Consent to operate is hereby refused under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

You may prefer on appeal against refusal order passed as per provision in the Water (P&CP) Act 1974 & the Air (P&CP) Act 1981 by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, in case aggrieved by the refusal order, within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of this refusal order.
