WHEREAS, you have applied for grant of Authorisation for import of Sodium Cyanide pure 1500 MTA for trading activity under Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

AND WHEREAS, as per sub-rule 2(c) of rule 13 of Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, For the import of other wastes listed in Part D of Schedule III, the importer who is a trader, importing waste on behalf of actual users, shall obtain one time authorisation from State Pollution Control Board.

AND WHEREAS, it is observed that the product you have proposed to be imported does not fall under Part D of Schedule III of Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, hence Maharashtra Pollution Control Board is unable to grant authorisation to your request of import.

NOW THEREFORE, your application for grant of Authorisation for Import and trading Sodium Cyanide pure 1500 MTA is hereby refused as per the provisions of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

You may prefer on appeal against refusal of authorisation passed by the State Pollution Control Board may, within a period of thirty days from the date on which the order is communicated to him, prefer an appeal in Form 12 to the Appellate Authority as per the provisions of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
