WHEREAS, you have applied for grant of Authorisation for import of S.S. MELTING SCRAP 500 MT/A (Part-D of Schedule-III) for trading activity under Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

AND WHEREAS, Board has issued Show Cause Notice vide above ref. (3) for refusal of authorization as

1. The copy of MOU with actual user, submitted by you, was only valid upto 31.3.2020.
2. You have mentioned the imported waste shall be stored at Madhusudan Compound, Bhiwandi before sending to actual user but not provided documents/ permission of the same.
3. You have not submitted copy of Import/ Export certificate and GST certificate.

AND WHEREAS, you have failed to submit satisfactory reply to Show cause notice despite of the sufficient and reasonable opportunity given for submission of the same.

NOW THEREFORE, your application for grant of Authorisation for Import and trading of S.S. MELTING SCRAP 500 MT/A (Part-D of Schedule-III) is hereby refused as per the provisions of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

You may prefer on appeal against refusal of authorisation passed by the State Pollution Control Board may, within a period of thirty days from the date on which the order is communicated to him, prefer an appeal in Form 12 to the Appellate Authority as per the provisions of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
