Sub: Refusal of Combined Consent to Operate & BMW Authorization renewal application under the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 10 (2) of the Bio-Medical Wastes Management Rules, 2016.

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WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6,8 and 25 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 has notified the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016, for proper management and handling of the Bio-medical Waste.

AND WHEREAS, refer to your application for grant of renewal of Combined Consent to Operate & BMW Authorization under the provisions under section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 Authorization under Bio-Medical Wastes Management Rules, 2016, received through Sub Regional Officer, Satara.


AND WHEREAS, it was brought to your notice that you have failed to submit required documents & information vide online scrutiny letters dated 26.06.2020, SCN for refusal issued on 07.08.2020 & opportunity of hearing given to you by extending personal hearing dated 18.09.2020 for submission relevant information, but have failed to submit followings: -

- i. You have submitted category & quantity of monthly BMW generation, but it is not as per the bed nos.
- ii. You have failed to submit Bank Guarantee of Rs. 1.5 lakhs as per the earlier CCA condition grated on 22.11.2018.
- iii. You have submitted installation of 10 CMD capacity STP, but details of water budget are not submitted.
- iv. You have submitted Maharashtra Jeevan Pradhikaran water bill but same is not by the name of Hospital.
- v. JVS analysis report dated 16.10.2020 of SRO, Satara indicates that the BOD parameter exceeds the CCA limit. It seems poor Operation & Maintenance of STP.
- vi. You have failed to submit sufficient fees for consideration of application upto 31.03.2023.

AND WHEREAS, non-submission of relevant information shows your negligent attitude towards implementation and management of Bio-Medical waste Management Rules, 2016.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the aforesaid non-submission of relevant information, your application for renewal of Combined Consent to Operate & BMW Authorization under the provisions under section 27 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 10 of the Bio medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 is hereby refused.

If you are aggrieved with the said refusal of Combined Consent to Operate & BMW Authorization application, you may prefer appeal under section 28 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the under section 31 Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and under rules 16 (1) of the Bio medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 before the Secretary, Environment Deptt., Government of Maharashtra, within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the said refusal order.
