Sub: Refusal of Consent to Operate under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 (4) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

Ref: Your application for grant of amendment in Consent to Operate (UAN No. MPCB-CONSENT_AMMENDMENT-0000020341)

WHEREAS, this office is in receipt of your application for grant of amendment in Consent to operate under section 26 of the Water (Prevention of Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

AND WHEREAS, the Board office has issued a Circular vide No. BO/MPCB/AS(T)/Circular/B-39 dated 25/08/2025 regarding "Applications for Amendment in Consent", wherein it has been decided that amendment applications shall be considered only for (i) typographical or clerical errors in the consent issued to the industry, (ii) change in the name of the industry, subject to supporting documentary evidence, and (iii) change in the disposal path of Hazardous Waste for pre-processing or co-processing, as per the policy of the Board. It has further been directed that all other applications for amendment in consent, which do not fall under the aforesaid categories, shall be declined at the SRO level without further processing.

AND WHEREAS, the Board has also issued a letter dated 30/03/2026 to the Central Pollution Control Board, seeking clarification regarding the applicability of consent requirements to pipelines associated with tank farms and isolated storage facilities handling petroleum products and other hazardous chemicals.

In view of the above, your application for grant of amendment in Consent to Operate is hereby refused under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21(4) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981. The application may be reconsidered after receipt of the clarification from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) regarding the applicability of consent requirements to the pipelines associated with tank farm/isolated storage facilities.
