1. Following Amendment in Existing Consent :

- The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
- This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/ permission from any other Government authorities.
- Industry shall obtain FIRE NOC from competent authority. The industry shall obtain permission from the Directorate of Industrial Safety & Health (DISH).
- Industry shall prepare on-site emergency plan and execute the same at the time of emergency.
- The industry shall comply with conditions stipulated in the Authorization issued by the Board.
- Industry shall not carry out any recycling activity without obtaining authorization under Rule (9) of the Hazardous & Other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

8. Industry shall strictly carry out the production as per the activity and quantity mentioned in the consent. In the event, any variation observed the said consent will be revoked with immediate effect and the Board will initiate stringent legal action against the project Proponent.
9. Industry shall recycle hazardous waste as per the SOP prepared by CPCB for the respective hazardous waste utilization. If, SOP is not available for the particular waste then industry shall apply to CPCB for preparation of SOP.
10. During the process of utilization and handling of hazardous waste, the unit shall comply with the requirements in accordance with the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991 as amended, wherever applicable.
11. All other conditions of existing consents to operate issued vide no. Format1.0/RO(BMW)/UAN No.0000289508/CR/2607001014 dt.12.07.2026 valid upto 31.07.2031 remain unchanged.
12. The applicant shall strictly comply with the circular issued by the Board vide No. MPCB / JD(APC) / NACP / DG Set / B-0090 dtd. 02/06/2023 regarding Retrofitting of Emission Control Device (RECD) for in-use Diesel Operated Internal Combustion Engines / D.G. Sets.
