WHEREAS, this office is in receipt of your application for grant of Consent to Establish under section 25 of the Water (Prevention of Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundry Movement) Rules, 2016.

Board issued circular vide no BO/MPCB/ AS(T) /Circular/ B-39 dtd. 25-08-2025 for amendment in consent for specific reasons. As per the circular your application for amendment in consent, which does not fall under the purview of the said category of the circular therefore, Board can not be considered your application for grant of consent.
