The capital investment of the unit is Rs. 109.11 Cr and capital investment of the land lord on land and building is Rs. 37.80 Cr = Rs. 146.91 Cr.

Grant of Amendment in Consent to Operate under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 6 and Rule 18(7) of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016 is considered and the amendment in consent is hereby granted subject to the following terms and conditions and as detailed in the schedule I, II, III & IV annexed to this order:

1. Following Amendment in Existing Consent :

- The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
- This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/ permission from any other Government authorities.
- Industry shall obtain necessary permission from the Directorate of Industrial Safety & Health (DISH) & Fire Department NOC time to time.
- The Public Liability Insurance (PLI) Act 1991 referred to PLI Act 1981 provides a mandatory Public Liability Insurance for an owner, industry or Installation handling its liability arising out of accident involving Hazardous Chemicals.

6. Industry shall not abstract and use ground water without obtaining permission from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA).
7. The industry shall comply with the provision of MSICH Rules, 1989 as amended thereafter and Without exceeding threshold planning quantity indicated in column 3 of schedule 2 & 3 of MSIHC Rules 1989 amended 2000.
8. The industry shall comply with provisions made in Plastic Waste Management & Handling Rules 2016, as amended and Maharashtra Plastic and Thermocol Products (MUSTH&S) Notification, 2018, as amended and obtained Registration as well as EPR under these rule as applicable.
9. The lessor and lessee will responsible for operation and maintenance of STP and in case of any violation both the party will liable for legal action.
10. The unit shall provide OWC for treatment and disposal of food waste / biodegradable waste within 3 months.
11. The applicant shall provide RECD (Retrofitting of emissions control devices) to the D.G. sets as per Board's circular within 3 months and comply with Board's circular dtd. 02/06/2023.
12. All the other conditions of the Consent referred at 1 shall remain unchanged. This amendment is valid only along with the Consent referred at sr. No. 1 above.
13. The applicant shall make an application for renewal of consent 60 days prior to date of expiry of the consent. (Operate/Renewal)

This consent is issued on the basis of information/documents submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent, if it has been observed that the information submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent is false, misleading or fraudulent, the Board reserves its right to revoke the consent & further legal action will be initiated against the Applicant/Project Proponent.
