Grant of Amendment in Consent to Operate under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 6 and Rule 18(7) of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016 is considered and the amendment in consent is hereby granted subject to the following terms and conditions and as detailed in the schedule I, II, III & IV annexed to this order:

1. Following Amendment in Existing Consent :

- The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
- This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/ permission from any other Government authorities.
- Industry shall comply with the EIA notification, dtd. 14.09.2006 and Amendments thereto.
- This consent is issued subject to obtain permission /NOC from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA) and MIDC in your premises for the use of ground water, if any.
- The industry shall obtain necessary permission from the Directorate of Industrial Safety and Health (DISH).
- The applicant shall make an application for renewal of consent 120 days prior to date of expiry of the consent.

8. Industry, the byproduct generator, should ensure that all the vehicles used to transport by-products to the (vendor) industry to be fitted with web based GPS system to record the origin to destination position and shall self-monitor the compliance and submit monthly report to the Board.
9. Industry shall obtain affidavit from industry stating that the by-product purchased from PP is used as raw material in their respective industries.
10. The applicant shall strictly comply with the circular issued by the Board vide No. MPCB / JD(APC) / NACP / DG Set / B-0090 dtd. 02/06/2023 regarding Retrofitting of Emission Control Device (RECD) for in-use Diesel Operated Internal Combustion Engines / D.G. Sets.
11. All other conditions mentioned in the existing Consent referred at Sr. No. 1 remain unchanged.
12. The industry shall create an Environment Cell by appointing an Environmental Engineer / Expert for looking after day-to-day activities related to Environment / Pollution control.

This consent is issued on the basis of information/documents submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent, if it has been observed that the information submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent is false, misleading or fraudulent, the Board reserves its right to revoke the consent & further legal action will be initiated against the Applicant/Project Proponent.
