Grant of Consent to Establish under Section 25 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 6 and Rule 18(7) of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016 is considered and the consent is hereby granted subject to the following terms and conditions and as detailed in the schedule I, II, III & IV annexed to this order:

1. Following Amendment in Existing Consent :

2. The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
3. This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/ permission from any other Government authorities.
4. The industry shall comply with the conditions of Environmental Clearance accorded vide No. SEAC-2012/CR-/TC2, dated 27/11/2012 & amendment vide No. SEAC-2011/CR. 808/TC.2, dated 18/01/2013.
5. The industry shall obtain necessary permission from the Directorate of Industrial Safety and Health (DISH).
6. This consent is issued as per the Office Order for Consent Management of the Board No. 12/2020 dtd. 23/12/2020.
7. The applicant shall not carry out any excess production or produce new products without Consent of the Board and without Environmental Clearance wherever it applicable.
8. The applicant shall properly collect, transport & regularly dispose-off the Hazardous Waste to CHWTSDF, in compliance of the Hazardous and other Waste (M & TH) Rule-2016 and keep proper manifest thereof.
9. Industry shall install online continuous monitoring system as per CPCB guidelines & data to be transmitted directly from Data Logger to Board server.
10. Industry shall comply with direction issued to CETP, regarding installation of two-way SCADA, Auto-sampler, Non-Return Valve (NRV) with positive discharge to CETP chamber.
11. Industry shall obtain PESO license / approval for storage of flammable Chemicals from the competent authority.
12. Industry shall comply with all the conditions stipulated in Environmental Clearance and ensure display/upload of six-monthly compliance monitoring report on their official website
13. Industry shall comply with the mechanism for Environmental management prepared by Central Pollution Control Board for CEPI listed areas, as industry falls under Severely Polluted Area (SPA) of CEPI.
14. Industry shall achieve TPM-50 mg/NM<sup>3</sup> being the unit is in CEPI area as per MPC Board policy and accordingly consent shall be amended for the stringent standards.
15. Industry shall ensure disposal of Hazardous Waste to the actual user having permission under Rule 9 of Hazardous and other Waste (M & TM) Rules, 2016.
16. For new storage facilities at site the unit should take requisite permissions/clearances from concerned departments like fire clearance, DISH etc.
17. This consent is issued pursuant to the decision of Minutes of 1st Technical Committee meeting under change in product mix (2025-2026) held on 24/04/2025 & 25/04/2025. This Consent is issued based on self-assessment of Pollution Load submitted by you in Board's prescribed format and Certificate of "No Increase in pollution load" issued by M/s. Aditya Environmental Services Pvt. Ltd. No. Nil, Dtd. Nil. If any violation and / or submission of misleading information are noticed, then the consent issued under MoEF & CC Product Mix Circular dtd. 14.12.2006 will stand automatically cancelled and you have to follow the procedure of EIA Notification, 2006 and Amendments thereof for obtaining Environmental Clearance.
18. The applicant shall obtain Consent to Operate from Maharashtra Pollution Control Board before actual commencement of the Unit/Activity.
19. This consent is issued with overriding effect on earlier Consent to Establish granted by the Board vide no. Consent No:- Format 1.0/AS(T)/UAN No.0000232649/CE/2506002827, dated 26.06.2025.
20. The industry shall create an Environment Cell by appointing an Environmental Engineer / Expert for looking after day-to-day activities related to Environment / Pollution control.
