Grant of Amendment in Consent to Operate under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 6 and Rule 18(7) of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016 is considered and the amendment in consent is hereby granted subject to the following terms and conditions and as detailed in the schedule I, II, III & IV annexed to this order:

1. Following Amendment in Existing Consent :

1	ELV End of life Vehicles(2 Wheeler & 3 Wheelers)	ELV End of Life Vehicles -18000 Kg/A

2. The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
3. This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/ permission from any other Government authorities.
4. Industry shall strictly follow the CPCB guidelines for environmentally sound facilities for Handling and Scrapping of End-of-Life vehicles(ELVs).
5. Industry shall strictly comply the previous consent conditions issued by the Board to the vehicle servicing unit located in the same premises.
6. Industry shall obtain CGWA NOC for extraction of ground water if any and shall comply the conditions of NOC.
7. The industry shall obtain fire NOC from the competent Authority.

8. The person involved in dismantling of ELV shall ensure that the vehicle has been declared as ELV (along with destruction certificate) and the registration of the vehicle has been cancelled as per Section 55 of the Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989. Such person shall apply for de-registration of the ELV in Form 20 A as per Rule 47a of Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989 to the registration authority.
9. Collection points or centers can be established in designated places where ELVs are collected. Such collection points could also be linked to a centralized collection center where these could be stored and later sent to dismantling/recycling plants.
10. The applicant shall comply with the point no. 14 for requirement for setting of ELC recycling facility as per mentioned in guideline for Environmentally sound Facilities for handling, processing and recycling of End-of-Life Vehicle (ELV) issued as per Jan-2019 & Revised guidelines in March 2023 respectively.
11. The applicant shall strictly comply with the guidelines / SOPs issued by the CPCB for Environmentally Sound Facilities for Handling, Processing and Recycling of End-of-Life Vehicles (ELV) in January 2019 & Revised guidelines in March 2023 respectively.
12. The applicant shall strictly comply with Board Circular vide No. MPCB/JD(APC)/NACP/DG Set/B-0090 dtd. 02/06/2023 regarding Retrofitting of Emission Control Device (RECD) for in-use Diesel Operated Internal Combustion Engines/D.G. Sets.
13. This consent is granted with overriding effect on earlier consent to operate granted by the Board vide No. 2605001804 dtd. 15/05/2026 which is valid up to 30/04/2030.
