1. Following Amendment in Existing Consent :

1	Disposal of treated trade effluent of quantity 01 CMD is get disposed through CETP	The industry shall ensure that the total industrial effluent generation shall not exceed 1.0 CMD. Out of the total industrial effluent, 0.5 CMD of high COD/high TDS effluent shall be segregated and sent to the M/s. SEE and CETP Joint Venture High COD/TDS Reduction Facility for further treatment in case of any contingency, as per Board's Direction No. MPCB/ROT/SCNP/2607200004/E-3340102 dated 20.07.2026.

- The Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke this consent and the same shall be binding on the industry.
- This consent should not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/permission from any other Government authorities.
- The industry shall obtain necessary permission from the Directorate of Industrial Safety and Health (DISH).

5. The applicant shall not carry out any excess production or produce new products without Consent of the Board and without Environmental Clearance wherever it applicable.
6. The applicant shall properly collect, transport & regularly dispose-off the Hazardous Waste to CHWTSDf, in compliance of the Hazardous and other Waste (M & TH) Rule-2016 and keep proper manifest thereof.
7. This Consent is issued subject to an order passed or may be passed by Hon'ble NGT in application no. 1038/2018 in the matter of CEPI
8. This consent is issued as per the copy of consent submitted by the industry vide no.Format1.0/BO/AST/TN-5803/15/R/GEN-6088 Dated 21.05.2015 on the basis of NIPL certificate Submitted by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Technical University.
9. Industry shall install online continuous monitoring system as per CPCB guidelines & data to be transmitted directly from Data Logger to Board server .
10. The applicant shall make an application for renewal of consent 120 days prior to date of expiry of the consent. (Operate/Renewal)
11. This consent is issued as per the Office Order for Consent Management of the Board No. 12/2020 dtd. 23.12.2020.
12. All the other conditions mentioned in ref.no. 1 remains unchanged
13. This is issued with the overriding effect over orders issued by the Board vide ref. no. 1
14. The industry shall create an Environment Cell by appointing an Environmental Engineer / Expert for looking after day-to-day activities related to Environment / Pollution control.
