Amendment in Consent to Operate under RED / LSI category with overriding effect on the existing consent to operate granted by the Board vide Ref. (1)

Grant of Amendment in Consent to Operate under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Rule 6 and Rule 18(7) of the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016 is considered and the amendment in consent is hereby granted subject to the following terms and conditions and as detailed in the schedule I, II, III & IV annexed to this order:

1. Following Amendment in Existing Consent :

Sr. No.	As per Existing Consent	Amended
1	The industry obtained Consent to Operate from the Board vide Consent No. Format1.0/AS(T)/UAN No.0000276450/CR/2603003237 dated 16.03.2026, valid up to 31.03.2031. At the time of applying for the consent, the industry had declared the following hazardous waste categories: 28.1, 35.3, 28.6, 28.2, 28.1, 36.1, 36.2, 33.1, 28.1, 28.4, 28.1, 28.4, 28.1, 28.3, 37.3, 35.4, 33.2, 35.2, and 20.3.	The hazardous waste generation categories specified in the existing Consent to Operate shall be amended as per the actual hazardous waste generated during regular plant operations. Accordingly, the hazardous waste categories 35.3, 28.6, 28.1, 36.1, 36.2, 33.1, 28.3, 37.3, 33.2, and 20.3 shall be retained in the consent, along with their respective generation quantities and disposal pathways. The remaining hazardous waste categories presently specified in the existing consent, which are not generated during regular plant operations, shall be deleted. All other existing consent conditions shall remain unchanged.

2. All the other conditions mentioned in ref.no. 1 remains unchanged

3. This is issued with the overriding effect over orders issued by the Board vide ref. no. 1
4. The industry shall create an Environment Cell by appointing an Environmental Engineer / Expert for looking after day-to-day activities related to Environment / Pollution control.

This consent is issued on the basis of information/documents submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent, if it has been observed that the information submitted by the Applicant/Project Proponent is false, misleading or fraudulent, the Board reserves its right to revoke the consent & further legal action will be initiated against the Applicant/Project Proponent.
